Safe Work Instrument

WorkSafe New Zealand Consolidation as at 12 November 2025

1 Title

This is the Health and Safety at Work (Hazardous Substances—Modified Application of Controlled Substance Licence Requirements for Specified Class 1 Substances) Safe Work Instrument 2023.

2 Commencement

This safe work instrument comes into force on 25 September 2023.

3 Overview

This safe work instrument—

- (a) deletes a specified hazardous substance in table 1 in Schedule 7 of the Regulations which has an incorrect UN number and description, and replaces it with the correct UN number and description; and
- (b) adds specified hazardous substances to table 1 and table 2 in Schedule 7 of the Regulations

4 Interpretation

(1) In this safe work instrument, unless the context otherwise requires,—

Act means the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015

Regulations means the Health and Safety at Work (Hazardous Substances) Regulations 2017

(2) A term or expression that is defined in the Act or the Regulations and used, but not defined, in this safe work instrument has the same meaning as in the Act or the Regulations.

5 Deletion of class 1 substance from table 1 in Schedule 7

For the purposes of regulation 9.4 of the Regulations, the following item is deleted from table 1 in Schedule 7 of the Regulations:

1.4B	UN0267	Detonators, non-electric (for blasting). Articles consisting of a small metal or plastic tube containing explosives such as lead azide, PETN, or combinations of explosives. They are designed to start a detonation train. They may be constructed to detonate instantaneously or may contain a delay element.
