Application information:

1. Note that the provisions of Regulation 109 only apply to regulations 27(2), 28, 29, 31, 33, 38, 44, 57, 59, 60, 61 AA, 74, 74E, 74G, 88, 89, 91, any provision in Part 5A and any provision in Schedule 8 of the Electricity (Safety) Regulations 2010.
